Summer Solstice Horse Show Association LLC is pleased to offer two one day B shows to answer the requests of exhibitors and trainers looking for a show to introduce new riders to showing and earn B circuit points. The following organizations will award B Points: American Saddlebred Association of Wisconsin, IASPHA, Mid-America Horse Show Association and Illinois Horse and Pony Breeder's Association. Summer Solstice Horse Show is an ASHA Star Show and a qualifier for the Monarch Show Series.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

None of the Summer Solstice Horse Show Association, LLC or its officers and directors, owners of the facility show manager, or any employee, independent contractor or volunteer of the show shall in any way, jointly or individually, be responsible for, or have any liability for, any loss, accident, damage or loss, includes loss of life, that may occur to any person, including any exhibitor, owner, trainer agent, groom, stable, animal, spectator, any property or equipment, sustained at, or as a result of the Summer Solstice Horse Show held at the Fox Valley Saddle Association in Hampshire, IL. All horses must be kept under control, and if they are not, may be barred from competition and entry fees forfeited at the discretion of show management. Every class offered which is covered by the rules of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES & NEGATIVE COGGINS: All horses shipped into the State of Illinois must have the required health certificates issued by a veterinarian from the state or region. These must be available for inspection during the show and be in accordance with Illinois State Law. Negative Coggins test for Equine Infectious Anemia required for each horse with the prior 12 months.

VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS: Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus, (Rhino pneumonitis) vaccinations with six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the show grounds upon request by Show Management. See USEF rule number GR845 for complete rule

Age of riders is as of December 1, 2023. Age division of riders: Jr. – 17 & Under, Sr. – 18 & Over.

Two minute gate holds between classes will be enforced. The gate person should be notified of tack changes at least 4 classes before needed.

Stalls are available between 3-6 PM Friday, June 21st, by entry form reservation only. Stalls for weekend, Friday through Sunday No refunds on stalls. We will require purchase of stalls if tying up to trailer will damage grass or grounds due to weather. Only one 19" box fan per stall may be used. Open check required at check in.

Open English Pleasure – Any breed – Open to Professionals.

ASHBA National Select Series Classes on Saturday, June 22nd—Classes with * Please note—If a horse shows in a Select Series class and then shows at Louisville, they will not be eligible to show back in the National Select Series National and/or Regional Championships later this year.

ASB Classic Pleasure – See IASPHA Rulebook.

School Horse Academy Classes—non-saddlbred types only.

ASHBA Alpha Class—The Alpha division is for riders that have either advanced beyond the Academy Division or are new riders entering show horse classes for the first time. These classes, unlike the novice or limit rider classes, will give riders two show seasons to compete at an entry-level of competition. The aim of this division is to give exhibitors an opportunity to gain more experience before moving up to compete against more experienced competition.

Championship Classes – Open to horses which have been entered, shown and judged in a qualifying class in their respective division. Championship classes will not be split. Academy Championships may be split with the exception of Jackpot Classes.

Two Minute Gate Hold Rule: A two minute gate hold will be enforced.

Equipment: Riders must wear appropriate equipment for style of riding. Any rider that is 10 years and under MUST wear protective head gear.

Ribbons and Trophies: Award for 1st place. Ribbons 1st-6th in all classes but academy; academy will ribbon 1st through 8th place.

Stabling and Bedding: The cost of stall rental is \$125.00 for the weekend, Friday through Sunday. Payment for tack stalls must be received with entries. Shavings must be ordered on entry blanks. No straw bedding. Stalls are available Friday after 3 PM and before 6PM. Facility closes at 6PM.

Camper Hook Ups: Camper hookups are available for \$60.00 for weekend and payable on entry blank. Electric only.
